General Tournament Info

1. Horses must be kept in stalls or paddocks overnight
2. Limited showers available on site.
3. Arrival no earlier than May 24th. Departure no later than May 27. Arrivals and/or later departures must be coordinated with the tournament secretary in advance. Michele Lahr labsec247@yahoo.com
4. **Umpire Horses:** Each team will need to provide a suitable umpire horse for their assigned games. Please include the name of the umpire horse(s) for your team with your entry form.
5. **Goal Tenders:** Teams will also need to provide at least one adult goal tender or one junior accompanied by an adult per game.

NOTES

1. Send your Coggins or bring to registration. All horses must have a current Coggins, in accordance with NC statutes – No Exceptions. NAME ON COGGINS MUST BE SAME AS NAME OF HORSE PLAYING IN TOURNAMENT AND LISTED ON THIS REGISTRATION FORM. Scan and send to secretary now labsec247@yahoo.com If for some reason, you can not email, you must bring your coggins to the registration table.
2. APA approved Helmets (per the APA rulebook) at all times while mounted
3. Underage drinking WILL NOT be tolerated in accordance with APA policies and NC statutes.
4. Tournament committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
5. Non-APA members may play but must pay the additional APA day membership fee of \$30.00 or \$20.00 for Junior
6. Please stay off the tracks.
7. Entry fee includes dinner and t-shirt for players only additions shirts \$15. Additional dinners are available and must be paid for in advance \$20/person
8. Trash cans are provided for trash. Please dispose of trash properly in cans provided or in dumpster
10. All pets must be on a leash or in a kennel area at all times. !
11. Smoking in the stables/stable areas (within 25 feet) is not permitted.
12. Open fires are not permitted.
13. The grounds will officially open at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, May 24th. The grounds will close at 1:00 PM on Monday, May 27 Any early arrivals and/or late departures must notify the tournament secretary in advance. Labsec247@yahoo.com
14. Teams will be placed in a division based on total Team rating. If there are any questions about this the tournament committee will be available for discussion on a case-by-case basis. Decisions of the tournament committee with respect to assigning teams to divisions are final.
15. Tournament committee reserves the right to reassign teams or individuals to divisions (move them up or down) as required. Tournament committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

17. Stalls must be totally stripped. Paddocks need to be picked out and hay needs to be removed. All manure and old hay needs to be dumped in the manure receptacles around each barn

- *From the North:* US 1 or US 15-501, exit at Morganton Rd in Southern Pines, turn right (west) toward Pinehurst. Follow Morganton to end, turn left (south) on NC 5. Entrance on left.
- *From the West:* Take US 220 (I-73/74 corridor) to NC 211 east toward Pinehurst. Turn right at NC5, Harness Track is 1.7 mi. on left.
- *From South:* US 1 to Aberdeen, turn left (west) on NC 5 to Harness Track, approx. 5 miles on right.
