The APA Player Development Program has been invited to participate in developing and attending an on going program, beginning with the following event. Once the determination has been made that we have enough interest to participate, The PDC will send out a formal application.

This tournament is designed to be an exciting, biannual international event that elevates both the play and profile of polocrosse in the Northern Hemisphere. We aim to create an event that helps mid level players in northern countries take the steps needed to play at a higher level. We also seek to draw spectators and sponsors in order to introduce more people to this amazing sport.

Date

- The first one will be held over the 2nd or 3rd weekend in July of 2020.
- It will be held every other year after that.

Location

- The Quad will take place in the UK.
- The venue must be spectator friendly.
- We would like the tournament to run concurrently with another event, i.e. wine festival, art fair, possibly another equestrian event, etc.
- The UK are currently looking into possible sites.

Teams and Players

- The nations competing will be Ireland, the UK, and the USA. The fourth team will be 'Team Europe' and will consist of players from various European countries.
- Each team will be comprised of four men and four women.
- Players must be 18 years of age as of January 1, 2020.
- Players will be strong 'B Grade'/low 'A Grade'. They will be the players who are ready to go to the next level but need that extra bit of help.

Horses

- All British and Irish players will provide at least two horses.
- We expect to get at least 10 horses from Europe.
- Horses will be graded the same way that they are for the World Cup.
- Umpire horses will be provided by the UK.
